The Westby Methodist Mission of the month for July is "Stuff The Bus". As usual, we will collect school supply items in early July so that they are ready to deliver before the end of the month. The supplies donated are distributed to families in Vernon County for whom buying school supplies is a financial hardship. With the high level of poverty in the county, any help parents can get during this expensive back-to-school season is very much appreciated. Families who wish to sign up to receive supplies must register by July 21 at https://form.jotform.com/241295118494158.

People who wish to make donations of money can also do so one line or make checks out to the church with Stuff the Bus on the memo line. Those who wish to donate supplies should bring them to the church before Sunday July 21. We can consult the supply lists for each school in stores to get suggestions of what supplies are needed. Be aware of things that may be forbidden at certain schools such as gel pens, or certain kinds of glues or paints that are known to be problematic. Backpacks are especially welcomed, and there is always a big need for standard items such as #2 pencils, spiral notebooks, folders, rulers, erasers, calculators, scissors and Crayola crayons (but not Dollar-Store crayons). If you bring the items to the church before the deadline, we will see that they are delivered. Dean Olson, a friend of Verna's, has agreed to play his guitar and sing that evening for entertainment. We will also need workers for that evening, and people to make salads and desserts. There are many ways for our entire church family, children included, to help. This will be an excellent way for Pastor Paul and our community to meet each other. Be watching for a sign-up sheet at church, we will need salads and bars to feed 150, plus at least 5 workers per shift. Thank you for helping our church outreach into our community.

Present: Pastor Erika, Julie Fargen, Ardith Hoff, Jean Shore, Kelly Bjornstad and Linda Weilnau **Opening:** Pastor Erika opened with prayer.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the May board meeting were emailed to the board and published in the June newsletter, so they could be reviewed prior to the meeting. Jean Shore and Julie Fargen motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Verna Drake provided the financial reports for May. These reports were emailed to the board members prior to the meeting. Ardith Hoff and Julie Fargen motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Old Business:

- ✤ VBS Planning Update Pastor Erika has an outline and some ideas for VBS that she will share with Jane Gaskell and Heidi Garrett, from Viroqua UMC, before she leaves.
- West Entrance Modification Update (Verna has left 2 phone messages for Ron Bjerkos (B&W Construction) about approach to automatic door. He knows there is a board meeting on the 12th and I wanted something from him, but nothing as of yet.) Verna Drake received a voicemail from Ron on June 13th with the following information: Ron said he is spinning his wheels in mud and if by God's grace he will get to us at some time.

New Business:

- Guest Speakers June 30 & July 7 Cavan Fang will be the guest speaker on June 30 and Tim Gaskell will be the guest speaker for July 7. If needed, Ardith Hoff can be a backup speaker for July 7.
- Create Updated Directory for Pastor Paul (with pictures?) Linda Weilnau will work to get updated pictures of everyone and send the updated information to Pastor Paul via email. It was decided to wear name tags in July to help Pastor Paul learn our names.
- Joint Outdoor Worship on July 21- This will be at Davidson Park in Westby. The service will begin at 10:00 AM, followed by a potluck. Pastor Erika suggested that we have a simple service and ask Pastor Paul if he'd like us to do something different since it will only be his 2nd Sunday with us.
- Burgers in the Park July 18 (Burgers in the Park July 18th we have Dean Olson arranged to play guitar and sing. We will need to decide what salads/bars and then have a sign-up sheet out probably by July 1st.) – It was decided to provide cole slaw, potato salad, watermelon and a variety of bars for this fundraiser.
- Possible Gathering to Meet Pastor Paul? It was decided to use the potluck after the Outdoor Worship service as the special gathering since many people from both churches will be there. Linda Weilnau will let Kathy Hanson know about this.
- Laptop for Church? Linda Weilnau suggested that the church purchase a laptop which can be used by the pastor when they are at our church, and it can also be used with the projector for showing things in the fellowship hall or even outside. Linda mentioned that the college will be having some used laptops available for sale. The cost is \$200. The laptop is a Dell Latitude 5500 model, is 5 years-old, has an i7 processor, 8 GB of memory and a 512 SSD hard drive. Ardith Hoff motioned to purchase a used laptop for \$200 from Western. Jean Shore seconded the motion. Motion passed. Linda will obtain the tax exemption information from Verna and discuss the details for making this purchase with her.
- Meals for Pastor Paul and His Family To welcome Pastor Paul and his family, Verna Drake suggested that we help to provide some food at the parsonage, gift card to Walmart and a gift card to a local restaurant and possibly a restaurant in Westby. Viroqua UMC is providing paper goods and some food. Pastor Erika suggested that we make some meals and drop them off at the parsonage, which will be a good way to introduce ourselves and make the welcome a little more personal than just providing gift cards. Linda Weilnau will email Pastor Paul to find out if they have any food allergies or preferences.

Business from Board Committees:

- Trustees Kelly Bjornstad reported that he still needs to change some lights in the kitchen.
- ✤ SPRC No report.
- Worship Pastor Erika said communion will be served during the service on June 23. We should ask Pastor Paul if he wants to serve communion on July 14th. Jane Gaskell will be providing music videos for the worship service on June 23 and 30 since she will be out of town.
- ✤ Education No report.
- ✤ Lay Leadership Ardith Hoff said she has written 5 more articles for the website and will send them to Linda Weilnau.

♥ Missions – Ardith Hoff reported that the July mission of the month will be Stuff the Bus.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Erika said that Cavan Fang will give a short report/summary about Annual Conference on June 30. She will give some of the documentation from the June ICD class to Linda Weilnau so Linda can scan it and send it out via email to everyone.

- Institute of Congregational Development Scott Carlson said that instead of having Pastor Paul joining the ICD courses in the middle, it will be better for Pastor Paul to attend the sessions next year. This would not cost us anything. They still need to make a final decision about this. The members of our congregations who are currently attending the ICD sessions will continue and finish the courses.
- Pastor Erika will not be able to move until the 1st week of July, because the current pastor in Lancaster will not be moving out of that parsonage until around June 26.
- We need to gather information about Westby UMC and give it to Pastor Paul when he arrives.
- There are potentially 3 confirmation students for next year, 2 from Viroqua (Luke and Henry) and 1 from Westby (Hailey).
- We should contact the newspaper, Vernon Times, about the change of pastors. Linda Weilnau said she will email Angie Cina about this and will copy Viroqua UMC. We should also let the other churches in Westby know about changing pastors.
- We need to contact the local funeral homes and give them Pastor Paul's contact information.
