Moving by Pastor Paul Lee

And they moved on from Succoth and encamped at Etham, on the edge of the wilderness. And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead them along the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, that they might travel by day and by night. The pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night did not depart from before the people. – Exodus 13:20-22 –

The main theme of the last month of my life was "Moving." Since I have moved a lot in my life, I expected that this move would not be difficult. However, as someone said, "Moving is always not happy." This move was also not easy for

my family. I wished to move in the middle of June to settle down well before starting the ministry. But the moving schedule was not set up as I expected. My school did not allow me to extend my stay at the school apartment, so my family was in a situation where we had to move out on June 30th and move into the parsonage on July 3rd. My family was depressed because of the delayed moving date and the worries of moving to a very new place.

While I was disappointed by many issues related to the move, God made me imagine the Hebrews in the wilderness. Hebrews in Exodus can be described as the people of "Moving." They did not know when or where they would move. They just obeyed God when the pillar of cloud and the pillar of fire moved. And every step of their moving, God always prepared their food, drink, and places to stay. I decided not to be worried but just to see how God led my family during the move.

Fortunately, the Annual Conference provided accommodation for three days, so my family did not need to drive long distances at once. God also prepared a great town and community. My family already feels at home in Westby. My son said, "Daddy, I want to live here forever!" Also, my family received a warm welcome from our church families. Many pastors told me that not many churches greet a new pastor like our church. They told me, "Paul, you are blessed because you could start your ministry at great churches." My heart and soul were full of disappointment and worries when I saw my situation. But, when I started to believe in God and rely on God, my disappointment and worries turned to gratitude and blessing.




Thursday Morning Prayer Group

Mission of the Month – Door of Hope



Opening: Pastor Paul opened with prayer.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the June board meeting were emailed to the board and published in the June newsletter, so they could be reviewed prior to the meeting. Ardith Hoff and Jean Shore motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Verna Drake provided the financial reports for May. These reports were emailed to the board members prior to the meeting. Verna indicated the June expenses were a little higher due to the insurance payments being quarterly instead of monthly. We are paid ahead for what we owe Viroqua UMC, so they are going to use some of this these funds towards the parsonage repairs. Verna indicated that the water meter reading was extremely high, but there weren't any events which would have caused this. She is going to keep watching this.

Old Business:

- VBS Planning on hold for Pastor Paul Viroqua UMC will be the host this year and it will be sometime in August. Jane Gaskell will ask Heidi Garrett from Viroqua when they will be able to meet with Pastor Paul. Linda Weilnau will email Pastor Paul the rough draft that Pastor Erika had created.
- West Entrance Modification next steps? Finney Concrete & Construction has been contacted about doing this job. Verna Drake called them and sent them pictures, so they can send an estimate.
- Updated Directory for Pastor Paul update Linda Weilnau sent this to Pastor Paul before he started.
- Joint Outdoor Worship July 21 & Potluck for Pastor Paul This event will be held at Davidson Park and start at 10 AM. We will plan the music for this service and provide the sound system. We will also provide coffee, lemonade, napkins and some extra plates. Verna Drake will make large lemonade ice cubes, so it doesn't get watered down when the ice melts. Verna will provide the lemonade. We will ask Donna Perkins if we can borrow her 30-cup coffee pot, because the electrical connections on the church's large coffee pots aren't good.
- Burgers in the Park July 18 Verna Drake reported that we don't have to put the salads in individual containers, we will be able to dish them out on the plate. We have enough workers and people to bring salads and bars.
- Laptop for Church update The laptop has been purchased. Linda Weilnau gave the sales receipts to Verna Drake. Linda will finish preparing the laptop, installing software and adding user accounts, and then bring it to church.



New Business:

- ✤ Potluck @ Viroqua UMC to welcome Pastor Paul July 14 This will be at 11:45 AM and we are invited to attend.
- Communication with Viroqua UMC There is a concern that communications between Viroqua UMC and Westby UMC could be improved. Discussed the possibility of having a liaison from each church meet with Pastor Paul periodically. This topic will be tabled until the August meeting, so we have more time to think about it.
- Membership List annual review Jane Gaskell reported that the membership list is up to date and current from after Charge Conference last fall.

Business from Board Committees:

- Trustees Verna Drake power washed the outside walls of the building, and she did a lot of weeding, so the weeding is caught up. Verna will try to find someone to paint the roof vents on the west side of the fellowship hall. There are still some more lights to replace in the fellowship hall and kitchen.
 - It was decided to turn on the fans in the sanctuary during exercise group and meal site times to help circulate the air more during the summer.
