Prayer is a powerful tool that God gave to us, and He wants us to use it, individually and as a group.


Please join us at 9:00 AM on Thursday, Sept. 5th for our monthly prayer group time.



Opening: Tim Gaskell opened with prayer.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the July board meeting were emailed to the board and published in the August newsletter, so they could be reviewed prior to the meeting. Jane Gaskell and Ardith Hoff motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Verna Drake provided the financial reports for June. These reports were emailed to the board members prior to the meeting. With our new pastor, the payroll expenses are reduced about \$200 per month. Verna Drake reported that the water bill did come back down after it was so high earlier this spring. Ardith Hoff and Jean Shore motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Motion passed.

"Super Heros" is the theme. There will be a meal around 5:30 PM. Jane Gaskell reported there will be about 7 students from Westby who plan to attend VBS.
