Mission of the Month – Operation Christmas Child




We have a goal to pack 12 - 15 boxes this year. The Packing Party will be during Sunday school in November.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the August board meeting were emailed to the board and published in the September newsletter, so they could be reviewed prior to the meeting. Julie Fargen and Jean Shore motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: August Financials will be sent later this month.

Old Business:

West Entrance Modification – Someone said that there are some new contractors that we could contact regarding this project: OG Concrete and One Shot. It was mentioned that we should also contact Janzens. Tim and Jane Gaskell will contact these contractors. There is the possibility of doing this ourselves, but we would need to check into the ADA requirements before doing it ourselves.
