## Thursday Morning Bible Study Group



As usual, our two favorite Christmas missions come due in November. Support for Baskets of Love and Norseland gifts both need to be gathered this month so that they can be distributed in early December. We will be collecting monetary donations for Baskets of Love, to purchase gift certificates for groceries for a Christmas meal for needy families, all month, and we will have a list of names of Norseland residents who need gifts. We will make this list available as soon as we can get it. The names come with suggestions for appropriate gifts costing around \$20 or so. Most of the suggestions are for practical items such as clothing and toiletries. Sometimes there

are specific suggestions for certain types of things such as word-search books or adult coloring books. You may choose the name of a person and shop for that specific person, or you can donate money and let other church members do the shopping. Either way, we will need to plan ahead so that the donations are at the church by the dates we will announce when we know them. **Present:** Pastor Paul Lee, Julie Fargen, Ardith Hoff, Jean Shore, and Jane Gaskell

Opening: Pastor Paul opened with prayer.

**Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the September board meeting were emailed to the board and published in the October newsletter, so they could be reviewed prior to the meeting. Ardith Hoff and Jean Shore motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Verna Drake provided the financial reports for September. These reports were emailed to the board members prior to the meeting. Verna recommended to move \$7,000 from checking to a Money Management account for an additional 1.2% interest. Ardith Hoff and Jean Shore motioned to approve the treasurer's report and to move the specified amount into a Money Management account. Motion passed. Verna provided a draft of the 2025 budget. It was reviewed and will be discussed further at the next meeting.

#### Old Business:

- ₩ West Entrance Modification Jade at One Shot Concrete stopped at the church last week and discussed specifics for a concrete handicapped ramp to run along the side of the building to the South. He will be providing an estimate.
- Pastor Appreciation Breakfast will be October 20<sup>th</sup> at 8:15 prior to the worship service. This will be a potluck.
- ❤ Westby Business Trick or Treating, October 31 Supplies have arrived 192 Flashlights and AA batteries. Due to Main Street road construction, trick or treating will be in an alternate location. The Westby Chamber will announce details when available.
- Charge Conference & Forms The Charge Conference is scheduled for November 13 at Viroqua UMC. This will most likely be a potluck followed by the conference. Pastor Paul will confirm the start time. Charge Conference forms are due October 30<sup>th</sup>. If there are issues logging into the UMC Portal to complete forms, contact the district office.

The Christmas Tree – Jane found trees online from \$400 to \$900. It was suggested to look on Black Friday or after Christmas for sales. Pastor Paul found trees more than half price on Amazon Prime Days that end tonight 10/9. Note: Jane ordered a 9-foot Dunhill Fir (without lights) for \$149, normally \$579.
