<u>Summary of John Wesley's Sermon, "The Scripture Way of Salvation"</u>

John Wesley's sermon "The Scripture Way of Salvation" explains how people are saved and grow in their faith, using simple ideas from the Bible. He focuses on Ephesians 2:8, which says, "By grace you are saved through faith." Wesley wants people to understand that salvation is a gift from God, not something we can earn by being good.

First, Wesley says that we are saved by grace. Grace means God's kindness and love that we don't deserve. We receive this grace through faith, which means trusting in Jesus Christ. Faith is not just believing with your mind—it means truly depending on Jesus in your heart.

When someone has faith, God forgives their sins. This is called justification. At the same time, God also changes their heart. This is called regeneration or being "born again." It's like starting a new life. From that point on, the person begins to live differently, wanting to please God and do what is right.

But salvation does not stop there. Wesley teaches that we are also sanctified, which means we grow to become more like Jesus. This is a lifelong journey of spiritual growth and becoming holy. God gives us the strength to turn away from sin and do good things. Wesley says that good work does not save us, but they are proof that we have real faith. If someone truly believes, they will show love, patience, peace, and other good qualities.

One special idea in Wesley's teaching is Christian perfection. This doesn't mean being perfect, like never making a mistake. Instead, it means having a heart full of love—loving God with all your heart and loving others as yourself. Wesley believed that with God's help, Christians can reach a point where they no longer have bad thoughts or selfish desires controlling them. This is also something we receive by trusting God, not by trying hard on our own.

In simple terms, Wesley says salvation is a journey. It begins when we first believe and are forgiven (justification), continues as we grow to become more like Jesus (sanctification), and can ultimately lead to a life filled with love (Christian perfection). All of this is possible only because of God's grace and love. We must always trust in God from beginning to end.

Wesley's message is that God wants to save us, change us, and fill us with God's love—and all we have to do is believe and keep trusting God.

Present: Ardith Hoff, Julie Fargen, Verna Drake, Tim Gaskell, Jane Gaskell, Jean Shore and Linda Weilnau **Opening:** Tim Gaskell opened with prayer.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the May board meeting were emailed to the board and published in the June newsletter, so they could be reviewed prior to the meeting. Verna Drake and Jane Gaskell motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Verna Drake provided the financial reports for May. These reports were emailed to the board members prior to the meeting. Verna Drake reported that there will be extra pastoral expenses for attending the Annual Conference, the first weekend of June. \$600 was pulled from the cemetery CD for stone care. Ardith Hoff and Jane Gaskell motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Old Business:

- ♥ West Entrance Railings We want to have handrails placed on the south side and part of the west side of the cement walkway of the west entrance. Tim Gaskell will contact some contractors to get bids for this project.
- Back entrance repair Fred Fronk Verna Drake reported that Fred Fronk will have this repair work completed by the end of June for about \$230. The fallen tree was cut up and removed for \$35.
- Insurance update Verna Drake reported that we are still waiting for the audit of the square footage of our church building from the insurance company.

- Church Cleaning We discussed as to whether to continue with our current cleaning person, who is supposed to clean the kitchen and the bathrooms twice a month. It was decided to continue with this person. Verna Drake and Jane Gaskell will review the cleaning list to see if adjustments can be made to possibly reduce the tasks on this list.
- ❖ Vision Meeting June 14 The list of questions for this discussion was emailed to the congregation prior. We will start at 8:00 AM and everyone will bring their own lunch.
- Small Group Meetings Verna Drake created the groups. Someone will be contacting the members of each group to arrange a meeting time for each group.
- Burgers in the Park July 17 Verna Drake purchased a section of fence to use for the Prayer Fence. We will have people write prayer requests on pieces of ribbon and then tie the ribbons to the fence. Our church will then pray for these prayer requests. Verna arranged for someone to perform music during this event. We will have a bake sale at this time and have a sign-up sheet so we don't have several people bringing the same item. We'll package some of the baked goods individually so they can be purchased for dessert. We will need people to be cashiers for the bake sale and some people to help serve the meals. The baked goods need to be at the church by 1:00 PM on July 17. Linda Weilnau will make blank name tags so we can let people know who we are and that we're part of Westby UMC.
- Growing in Faith Study Group It was decided to pause this group for now and see how it may fit into our Vision Planning.

New Business:

- Father's Day It was decided to give out some homemade cookies and Jane Gaskell will make a note to put on the bags.
- Outdoor service July 20 @ Ekhart Park, Viroqua This service will be at 10:00 AM. There will be a potluck afterwards and everyone needs to bring their lawn chairs for the service. Linda Weilnau isn't able to attend this service, so Verna Drake will record the message and scripture reading.
- ❖ Cybersecurity Warranty Statement This item was discussed and then signed by Tim Gaskell.

Business from Board Committees:

- Trustees Verna Drake has the paint and will start painting the narthex before the end of June.
- ❖ SPRC An email was sent out, requesting that the SPRC groups from both churches meet to discuss the percentage each church pays for the pastor's salary.
- ₩ Worship Guest speakers in June We may need a guest speaker for June 29. Someone will see if a person from Viroqua can do both churches that Sunday.
- ❖ Youth June 22 Jump Park Fun Day | VBS Planning The youth will be going to the Jump Park during the afternoon on June 22. The tentative date for VBS is Aug. 10. Jane Gaskell said she is considering a Lego theme. VBS will be with Viroqua UMC and planning will begin in July.

- ♣ Missions The mission of the month for July will be Stuff the Bus because this organization wants the school supplies delivered to them the first part of August.
