New Birth

We are continuing to learn about the doctrine of early Methodists. We are especially studying the Way of Salvation, which Wesley identified as essential to understanding their doctrine. I have shared that there are two main pillars in the early Methodists' view of salvation: Justification and Sanctification. Before Justification, humans go through the step of Repentance. Then, humans experience Justification, where they are assured by God that they are righteous. At the same time, or immediately after Justification, people experience the "New Birth." This New Birth is the gate and start of Sanctification.

New Birth is a very important part of the Christian life. It means being born again. John Wesley explained about New Birth in his sermon "The New Birth" well. He explains that every person must go through a spiritual change in order to be saved and have a real relationship with God. This is what Jesus meant when He said, "You must be born again" (John 3:7).

Wesley says that when we are born the first time, we are born with a sinful nature because of Adam's sin. This means we are naturally selfish, far from God, and unable to truly love or obey God. Even if someone tries to be a good person, goes to church, or follows the rules, it's not enough. A deep, inner change is needed.

The new birth is a work of God. It's something the Holy Spirit does in a person's heart. It's not something we can do by ourselves. When we are born again, God gives us a new heart. We begin to love God, want to do what is right, and live a holy life. Our thoughts, feelings, and actions start to change. This is the beginning of real Christian life.

Wesley explains that this new birth happens through faith. It's not just about believing facts about God — it's about trusting in Jesus, turning away from sin, and receiving God's grace. When this occurs, we are forgiven and also transformed.

The new birth also leads to a new way of living. A person who is born again will show love, kindness, patience, and other fruits of the Spirit. They will not be perfect, but their life will be different because God is now working in them.

Wesley warns that no one should think they are saved just because they were baptized, go to church, or try to be good. These things are not the same as being born again. Only through the new birth can we become true children of God.

We will use money from the Cookie Walk and the general funds to pay for having the parking lots seal coated. Ardith Hoff and Jane Gaskell motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Old Business:

- ₩ West Entrance Railings 2 businesses contacted for bids Both businesses were contacted and asked them to stop by to check on this request. We are waiting for estimates.
- Back entrance repair Fred Fronk (Handicap door check needed) Mr. Fronk said it will cost \$230 to repair the railing. He hasn't had time to do it yet. We also need Fred to check the bolt on top arm of the handicap door because the bolt is bent.
- ♣ Insurance update No new information at this time. We are still waiting for our square footage audit.

- ❖ Small Group Meetings on hold for July Fellowship time & personal time We encourage everyone to be praying for God's vision for our church. We will continue to discuss this during fellowship times.
- Burgers in the Park July 17 Bake sale and prayer activity The sign-up sheet to provide baked goods and to help with the bake sale and prayer fence is in the narthex and it was also emailed to the congregation. We are doing this to be a presence in the community.
- Outdoor service & Potluck July 20 @ Ekhart Park, Viroqua (Westby to supply sound system) The service begins at 10 AM. There will be small group discussions, similar to last year's joint service. Will need to bring a lawn chair and your own plates and silverware.

New Business:

- Review Membership list: Hailee Janzen (new member completed confirmation) Hailee has been added to the membership book.
- Exchange student email The church received an email asking if anyone from the church would be able to host an exchange student, or if we could refer someone to host a student. If we referred someone to host a student, a donation would be made to our church.
- Adams Voice Performance We received an email from the group, Adams Voice, indicating they would be in the area Sept. 20 & 21 and that they would like to perform at our church. They requested a free will offering and a meal for the group. It was decided to decline this performance at this time. Linda Weilnau will email a reply to the group.

Business from Board Committees:

- Trustees The parking lot seal coating is in progress. We need more light bulbs replaced in the fellowship hall and some of the cylinder lights in the sanctuary. Kelly Bjornstad will look into getting some of these replaced.
- ❖ SPRC As of July 8, the Conference indicated that pastor would receive health and pension benefits during this interim period. District Superintendent Amanda Stein suggested thinking about the possibility of merging with another church due to low attendance numbers.
- ₩ Worship guest speakers in July Layne Hanson will be the guest speaker at both Westby & Viroqua on July 13. Tim Gaskell will be the guest speaker at both churches on July 27, if needed. Viroqua UMC is checking into possible guest speakers for August, if needed.
- ❖ Youth VBS August 10 VBS will be from 4-7 PM and will be held at Westby UMC this year. The theme is "Build Your Faith" and Legos. There will be a joint meeting with both churches on July 15 at 2 PM, at Westby UMC.

- Missions Compassion Internation Community Gift will be the mission of the month for August. The gift will be something that will help to sustain a community, such as animals.
